USED ENGINE WARRANTY STATEMENT

Warranty Terms:

Used Engines carry a 25 DAY/500 MILES warranty on Engine Rotating assembly ONLY (Engine Block, Crankshaft, Connecting Rods, Pistons, Cylinder Head(s), camshafts, valvetrain). There is NO WARRANTY ON ANY ACCESSORIES INSTALLED ON ENGINE (Timing belts/chains and components, Intake and exhaust manifolds, alternators, starters, sensors, seals and gaskets, injectors, coil packs, etc are NOT WARRANTIED!) Customer will be responsible for all labor, fluids, shop and hazmat charges should a failure occur within the 25 DAY/500 MILES warranty period. This warranty DOES NOT cover TOWING, lost wages, rental fees, or any other fees, charges or inconveniences associated with a covered engine failure. This warranty does not cover any damage that may occur to other parts of vehicle as a result of failure of the engine. This warranty does not cover any damage that may occur to the engine as a result of a failure of any other component of the vehicle. THIS WARRANTY WILL BE CONSIDERED VOID IF THERE IS ANY EVIDENCE OF OVERHEATING, OR FAILURE TO MAINTAIN CORRECT FLUID LEVELS.

There is a 25 DAY/500 MILES warranty on the QUALITY OF WORKMANSHIP of engine installation. This means we guarantee that everything is correctly installed, all fluids are filled, and all required parts are transferred to the replacement engine as recommended by the manufacturer of the vehicle. THIS WARRANTY DOES NOT COVER LABOR CHARGES TO REMOVE AND INSTALL A FAILED ENGINE UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES! We do not sell the engines, all engines are purchased from a third party and simply billed to the customer. Therefore The Car Doctors cannot be held responsible for engines that fail or are DOA (Dead On Arrival). CUSTOMER WILL BE CHARGED FOR ALL LABOR REQUIRED TO REMOVE AND REINSTALL A FAILED ENGINE, EVEN IF THE ENGINE ITSELF IS STILL UNDER WARRANTY.

SPECIFICALLY EXCLUDED FROM ANY WARRANTY IS ENGINE FAILURE DUE TO TIMING BELT OR ANY OTHER TIMING COMPONENT FAILURE. To avoid major engine damage, timing components are required by the vehicle manufacturers to be replaced at certain mileage and time intervals, and with most used engines mileage and/or previous replacement is impossible to verify. Therefore, The Car Doctors cannot be held responsible for condition of timing components at the time of installing a used engine, and will not accept warranty claims due to broken timing belts or failed timing components. To eliminate possibility of failure, ask us about discounted timing belt/component replacement prior to engine installation.

Replacement of warrantied component does not extend warranty term. Limit 1 claim per warranty term. Warranty work will not receive priority scheduling. ALL WARRANTY CLAIMS MUST BE MADE AT THE CAR DOCTORS, and any warranty work must be performed by us. Any claims for repairs performed at other repair facilities will be denied. Any warranty will be considered void if there is evidence of tampering with or removing markings from the engine and its components, or if any work is done to the engine by someone other than The Car Doctors.

Additionally, this Warranty does not cover:

- A. Normal Wear and Tear.
- B. Failure due to Accident or Collision.
- C. Failure due to Road Hazards or Act of God (Lightning, Flood, Fire, etc.)
- D. Failure due to misuse, abuse, modification, or off-road use of vehicle
- E. TOWING, Rental Fees, Impound and Storage Fees, Traffic Fines, Lost Wages, Inconveniences, or any other incidental expenses
